



VOLUNTEER CODE OF CONDUCT

Students partaking in a volunteer program that is initiated by Conestoga Students Incorporated (CSI), including the Leadership Ambassador Program, and Clubs & Societies, must agree to the following terms and conditions.

1. Volunteers must treat peers, fellow students, faculty, staff, and members of the community with respect, dignity, and courtesy. This applies to treating everyone with the highest level of esteem regardless of gender, age, sexual orientation, race, ability, religion, background, or any other differences.
2. Volunteers are expected to represent CSI with maturity, respect, and professionalism both while volunteering and in every day conversation
3. Volunteers must have a professional, respectful, and mature online presence (on social media outlets, within correspondence, etc.)
4. It is expected that volunteers take their role seriously and remain reliable and professional while actively involved in a program(s).
5. Volunteers should immediately contact the Student Engagement Coordinator if a conflict arises that impacts:
 - a. Student availability
 - b. Student safety while volunteering
 - c. Or the student's volunteering experience in any other way
